<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Rally	Noun	Gather, come together.
Confederate	Adjective	Related to the Confederate States of America during the Civil War
Emblem	Noun	something that visually symbolizes an object, idea, group, or quality
Desegregation	Verb	to put an end to a customary or enforced separation of ethnic or racial groups in a place or institution, e.g. in a workplace or school
Denounced	Verb	Criticize publically
Agenda	Noun	a formal list of things to be done. In the political world it is what a politician plans to accomplish in that legislative year
Mandates	Noun	an official command or instruction from an authority
Null and Void	Adjective	Invalid, having no legal validity
Referendum	Noun	a vote by the whole of an electorate on a specific question or questions put to it by a government or similar body
Divisive	Adjective	Causing disagreement or hostility within a group so that it is likely to split
