<u>Word</u>	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Notorious	Adjective	Famous for something bad
Halt	Noun	An end of temporary stop
Horrific	Adjective	frightening or disturbing enough to cause horror
Exposure	Noun	Contact with the environment that has a harmful or beneficial effect
Unsanitary	Adjective	Dirty or unhygienic and likely to cause disease
Mortality Rate	Noun	the number of deaths in a place or group compared with the total number of people in that place or group
Bore	Verb	To take on a burden and blame
Brunt	Noun	The main force of something
Commemorating	Verb	To remember something ceremonially or to set up a memorial to something or someone
