Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Swindle	Verb	to obtain something from somebody, especially money, by deception or fraud
Landmark	Noun	a prominent structure or geographic feature that identifies a location and serves as a guide to finding it
Foul	Adjective	disgusting to the senses
Shares	Verb	to have or use something in common with other people; to allow somebody to use something or have part of something
Land Companies	Noun	Company that buys and/or sales land
Corruption	Noun	Dishonest; uses power for personal gain
Repeal	Verb	to officially end something such as a law
Titles	Noun	a legal right to possess and dispose of property
Unconstitutional	Adjective	not allowed by or against the principles set down in a constitution, especially a nation's written constitution
Rescind	Verb	to remove the validity or authority of something; to declare a decision null and void
Galvanize	Verb	to stimulate somebody or something into great activity; to coat a metal, usually iron or steel, with zinc to prevent corrosion
