<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Showdown	Noun	A confrontation to settle a conflict
Federal Government	Noun	The central government of the United States which includes three branches (executive, judicial, legislative).
Negotiated	Verb	to attempt to come to an agreement on something through discussion and compromise
Authorized	Verb	To give permission of power to do something
Voided	Adjective	Made not valid
Treaty	Noun	a formal contract or agreement negotiated between countries or other political entities
Militia	Noun	an army of soldiers who are civilians but take military training and can serve full-time during emergencies
Confrontations	Noun	conflict between ideas, beliefs, or opinions, or between the people who hold them
