<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Infamous	Adjective	Being famous for something bad. having an extremely bad reputation
Trail of Tears	Noun	a name given to the forced relocation and movement of Native American nations from southeastern parts of the United States following the Indian Removal Act of 1830.
Fuss and Feathers	Noun	Name for things that are Fancy, elaborate, full of yourself, pretentious
Ejection	Verb	To force somebody to leave a place or give up a position,
Catapulted	Verb	to push somebody unexpectedly and suddenly into a particular situation
Spotlight	Noun	The focus of public attention
Tragic	Adjective	Deeply sad, creating deep sadness, distress or grief
