<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Flanking	Verb	The attack on the left or right side of a military formation
Frustrating	Verb	to make somebody feel disappointed, exasperated, angry, annoyed or weary because they have not gotten what they want.
Desperate	Adjective	Extreme, last resort, drastic, reckless
Assault	Noun	A violent physical or verbal attack
Fortified	Verb	To make a place safer by building or creating defensive structures such as walls or ditches
Carnage	Noun	Serious injury or death to a large number of people in battle or major accident
