<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Appointment	Noun	the selection of somebody for a position, office, or job
Privy Council	Noun	the committee that advises a British king or queen. It consists mainly of present and former members of the Cabinet.
Sovereign	Noun	the ruler or permanent head of a state, especially a king or queen
Viscount	Noun	a British nobleman of a rank above baron
Committee	Noun	a group of people appointed or chosen to perform a function on behalf of a larger group
Champion	Noun	a defender, supporter, or promoter of somebody or something
Earldom	Noun	The territory and rank of an earl.
