 Vocabulary

<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Disenfranchise	Verb	To deprive a person of a right of citizenship, especially the right to vote.
Amend	Verb	To change, alter, modify, or rephrase
Impose	Verb	To lay down or enforce something that is required for everyone.
Literacy	Noun	the state of being able to read or write
Explicitly	Adjective	Clearly or obviously
Disqualify	Verb	to make or declare somebody unfit, unqualified, or ineligible to do or take part in something
Exemptions	Noun	permission or entitlement not to do something that others are required to do
Descendants	Noun	Somebody related to someone that lived in the past
