<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Eloquent	Adjective	Having or exercising the power of fluent, forceful, and appropriate speech.
Coordinated	Verb	To organize, plan, put together
Allusions	Noun	A reference to somebody or something
Imperatives	Noun	something that must be done
Lyrical	Adjective	Like poetry or music
Cadence	Noun	Rhythmic flow of a sequence of sounds or words, as when giving a speech.
Garnering	Verb	To get; acquire; earn.
Nobel Peace Prize	Noun	Every year since 1901 the Nobel Prize has been awarded for achievements in physics, chemistry, physiology or medicine, literature and for peace. The Nobel Prize is an international award administered by the Nobel Foundation in Stockholm, Sweden. In 1968, Sveriges Riksbank established The Sveriges Riksbank Prize in Economic Sciences in Memory of Alfred Nobel, founder of the Nobel Prize. Each prize consists of a medal, personal diploma, and a cash award.
