Glossary

Widowed: verb; to have lost a husband by death and to have not remarried.

Discipline: noun; training to act in accordance with rules.

Endorsed: verb; to approve or support.

Asserted: verb; stated with assurance, confidence, or force; strongly affirm.

Staunchly: adverb; in a firm manner; steadfastly.

Convention: noun; a meeting or formal assembly of delegates or representatives to nominate candidates to an office or to discuss action on matters of common concern.

Scholarship: noun; a sum of money or other aid granted to a student, because of merit or need, to pursue his or her studies.
