#### Glossary

Cavalry: noun; the part of a military force composed of troops that serve on horseback.

Distinction: noun; marking or treating with special honor, attention, or favor.

Embodiment: noun; the state of personifying or exemplifying in actual form.

Frontier: noun; the land or territory that forms the furthest extent of a country's settled or inhabited regions.

Promoted: verb; advanced in rank or position.

Rebels: noun; a person who refuses allegiance to and rises against his or her government or country.

Reunion: noun; the state or condition of having been brought together again.

Theater: noun; a place of action or field operations.
