<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Duel	Noun	A fight with guns to settle a disagreement
Minister	Noun	a senior officer of state in a government department, especially in the parliamentary system of government
Candidate	Noun	somebody who is being considered for a political office or an official position
Prominent	Adjective	Well-known, distinguished
Rivals	Noun	a person or group that competes with another
Stroke	Noun	a sudden blockage or rupture of a blood vessel in the brain resulting in, e.g. loss of consciousness, partial loss of movement, or loss of speech.
Electoral Vote	Noun	The United States Electoral College is the official name of the group of Presidential Electors who are chosen every four years to cast the electoral vote and thereby elect the President and Vice President of the United States.
