<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Strict	Adjective	severe in maintaining discipline, or rigorous in ensuring that rules are obeyed
Ordained	Verb	to appoint somebody officially as a priest, minister, or rabbi
Anglican	Noun	Protestant denomination. Official Church of England in the 18 th century
Methodical	Adjective	Systematic, painstaking
Missionaries	Noun	Somebody sent to another country by a church to spread tis faith or to do social and medical work
Propagation	Verb	to spread an idea or custom to many people
Rector	Noun	a member of the Anglican clergy who is in charge of a parish
Magistrate	Noun	a judge in a lower court whose jurisdiction is limited to the trial of misdemeanors and the conduct of preliminary hearings on more serious charges
Reputation	Noun	the views that are generally held about somebody or something, a high opinion that people hold about somebody or something
Denomination	Noun	a religious grouping within a faith that has its own system of organization
