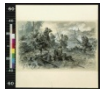

Compromise of 1850      National Archives

Resolution introduced by Senator  
Henry Clay in relation to the  
adjustment of all existing  
questions of controversy between  
the states arising out of the  
institution of slavery (the  
resolution later became known as  
the Compromise of 1850),  
January, 29, 1850; Senate Simple  
Resolutions, Motions, and Orders  
of the 31st Congress, ca.  
03/1849-ca. 03/1851; Record
