<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Cash Crop	Noun	a crop grown for direct sale, and not for personal consumption
Depression	Noun	a period in which an economy is greatly affected by unemployment, low output, and poverty
Industry	Noun	organized economic activity connected with the production, manufacture, or construction of a particular product or range of products
Distribution Center	Noun	Centrally located area where products are brought to be loaded and sent out to stores all over the area
Designated	Verb	to choose something for a particular purpose
Commodities	Noun	an item that is bought and sold, especially an unprocessed material
