 Vocabulary

<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Conservative	Adjective	in favor of preserving the status quo and traditional values and customs, and against abrupt change
Security	Noun	the state or feeling of being safe and protected
Revolution	Noun	the overthrow of a ruler or political system
Fervor	Noun	Intensity, passionate
Militia	Noun	An army of soldiers who are regular citizens
Tensions	Noun	Uneasy feelings, a state of mistrust and some hostility
Continental Troops	Noun	Troops from the original 13 colonies that would later become the United States
Brigade	Noun	Military unit with two or more combat battalions or regiments
Continental Congress	Noun	the congress of delegates from the American colonies held before, during, and after the American Revolution. It issued the Declaration of Independence (1776) and drafted the Articles of Confederation (1777).
