 Vocabulary

<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Staunch	Adjective	showing loyalty, dependability, and enthusiasm
Segregationist	Noun	Supporter of segregation
Defying	Verb	To openly challenge or resist a command, regulation, or someone's authority
Crimps	Verb	To interfere with something, to hinder a plan or process
Integrate	Verb	To make something open to all regardless of race, ethnicity, religion, gender, or social class
Complex	Noun	A group of buildings dedicated to one purpose
Nuclear Reactor	Noun	A device producing heat energy from nuclear fission
Corruption	Noun	Dishonesty for personal gain, using power for personal gain
Oath	Noun	Solemn promise, a formal or legally binding pledge to do something such as tell the truth in a court of law, made formally and often naming God or a loved one as a witness
