Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Career	Noun	Long-term of lifelong job
Hostility	Noun	a feeling or attitude of hatred, enmity, antagonism, or anger toward somebody
RBIs	Noun	Runs batted in or RBIs is a statistic used in baseball and softball to credit a batter when the outcome of his at-bat results in a run being scored, except in certain situations such as when an error is made on the play.
Footsteps	Noun	To take the same course in life or work as another person in the past
Civil Rights	Noun	Basic rights, rights that all citizens of a society are supposed to have, e.g. the right to vote or to receive fair treatment from the law. These rights as conceived in U.S. law are set forth in the 13th and 14th Amendments to the U.S. Constitution and in some congressional acts.
