<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Court-Martial	Noun	A military court that tries members of the military and others for offenses under military law
Neglect	Verb	To fail to do something, especially because of carelessness, forgetfulness, or indifference.
Commission	Noun	An appointment to the rank of officer in the armed forces, or a document conferring such a rank
Confederacy	Noun	Confederate States of America – the group of states that seceded from the Union
Distinguished	Verb	To set apart
Lacking	Adjective	Not enough
Aggression	Noun	Attack, hostile action, especially a physical or military attack directed against another person or country, often without provocation
Relieved	Verb	To dismiss or suspend somebody from a job or position
Exonerated	Verb	To free somebody from blame or guilt. To declare officially that somebody is not to blame.
Pantheon	Noun	A group of people who are the most famous or respected in their field.
