Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Duo	Noun	a pair of closely related people. In this case a pair of actors who often appear together.
Comedy	Noun	Funny play, movie, or book
Tribute	Noun	Something said or given to show gratitude, praise, or admiration.
Bumbling	Adjective	Clumsy, speaking or behaving in a clumsy or confused way
Whimpering	Verb	to complain in a weak, whining, or irritated manner
Foil	Noun	A foil is a character who serves as a contrast to another perhaps more primary character, so as to point out specific traits of the primary character.
Twiddling	Adjective	to keep twisting something or turning it around in a bored or absent-minded way
