Vocabulary

<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Chief Executive	Noun	the highest-ranking member of an executive body, e.g. the head of a government or the governor of a U.S. state
Revolutionary	Adjective	relating to the war with Great Britain fought by the American colonists
Provincial	Adjective	Belonging to or coming from a particular administrative region or division of a country
Delegate	Noun	somebody who is chosen to represent or given the authority to act on behalf of another person, group, or organization, e.g. at a meeting or conference
Unsurpassed	Adjective	Better than anyone else before or after. No one has done better
Expedition	Noun	a trip made by a group of people for a particular purpose, e.g. to explore unknown territory, to do scientific study, or to achieve a military objective
Exemplary	Adjective	so good or admirable that others would do well to copy it
