Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Privilege	Noun	Restricted right or benefit
Necessity	Noun	Something that you need not just want
Orchestra	Noun	a large group of musicians playing classical music, consisting of sections of string, woodwind, brass, and percussion players, and directed by a conductor
Choral	Adjective	Arranged for or performed by a chorus or choir
Innovator	Noun	An inventive person. A person who introduces new ways of doing things
Singlehandedly	Adjective	Accomplished alone without help
Collegiate	Adjective	Involving, belonging to, appropriate to, or being a college.
Chorale	Noun	A group of singers
Foremost	Adjective	Most important or notable
Repertoire	Noun	The range and amount of musical material a group is prepared to preform
Renaissance	Noun	A revival. Especially related to arts and culture.
