Govern	Verb	To be responsible officially for directing the affairs, policies, and economy of a state, country, or organization
Ignorance	Noun	Lack of knowledge
Revolution	Noun	A major dramatic change. In the case of the Revolutionary war it was a complete overthrow and change of government
Fledgling	Adjective	Young, inexperienced
Republic	Noun	Political system with elected representatives
Charter	Noun	Formal document establishing an organization, company, or educational institution
Secular	Adjective	Not related to religion
Clarion Call	Noun	a direct public request for people to take action
Independent	Adjective	Not controlled by another person especially in this case a king or queen.
Statehood	Noun	The status of a stat in the United States of America
Flourishes	Verb	steady strong growth
Enlightenment		an 18th-century intellectual movement in Western Europe that emphasized reason and science in philosophy and in the study of human culture and the natural world
Philosophy	Noun	the study of the basic ideas like truth, existence, reality, freedom, liberty, government
