<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Benefactor	Noun	Somebody who supports a cause such as the arts, the support is usually money
Southern Belle	Noun	Stereotype of a beautiful upper-class woman living in the “old south.”
Privilege	Noun	Rights and advantages enjoyed by a small group with wealth and status
Formidable	Adjective	Inspiring respect or wonder because of size, strength, or ability
Intellect	Noun	Mental ability, somebody’s ability to think, reason, and understand
Disdain	Noun	Disgust for somebody or something
Notion	Noun	Idea, opinion, thought
Dependent	Noun	A person who cannot get by without the support of another
Pedestals	Noun	The position of being admired by somebody as if they were standing on a base that supports a statue
Regency-style	Adjective	The <i>Regency style</i> of architecture refers primarily to buildings built in Britain during the period in the early 19th century when George IV was Prince Regent
