<u>Word</u>	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Terrorism	Noun	violence or the threat of violence, especially bombing, kidnapping, and assassination, carried out for political purposes
Phenomenon	Noun	A fact or occurrence that can be observed
Disenfranchising	Verb	to keep an individual or group from the right to vote
Immigration	Noun	the act of entering a new country to live there
Anarchist	Noun	Somebody who believed that there should be no government; somebody who tries to overthrow a government or behaves in a lawless way
Appointed	Adjective	Named to a position
Opposing	Verb	To be against something
Assassination	Noun	the killing of somebody, especially a political leader or other public figure, by a sudden violent attack
