Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Moderation	Noun	The state or act of not being extreme or radical, taking a middle-of —the road position
Divisive	Adjective	Causing disagreement or hostility within a group that is likely to split or divide
Editor	Noun	the overall supervisor of content for a book, newspaper, or magazine
Die-Hard	Adjective	Extreme, willing to die for their beliefs or position, unwilling to change mind.
Segregationist	Noun	A supporter of the policy of separating people based on race
Integration	Noun	the process of opening a group, community, place, or organization to all, regardless of race, ethnicity, religion, gender, or social class
