Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Draw	Verb	to pull something, or lead or pull somebody, in a particular direction, especially toward or away from something
Box Office	Noun	the place where tickets are bought for entertainments such as movies, plays, or concerts, ticket sales for a theatrical or cinematic entertainment, or the income from these sales
Adaptation	Noun	something that has been modified to suit different conditions or a different purpose
Shot	Verb	Film a movie
Contributions	Noun	the part played by somebody or something in causing a result
Industry	Noun	organized economic activity connected with the production, manufacture, or construction of a particular product or range of products
