Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Colonists	Noun	Somebody living in a new colony, An immigrant to a new colony, or one of the founders of it
Bluff	Noun	a high steep bank, cliff, or headland, especially one with a broad face
Trustees	Noun	A board with members that make decisions and govern a newly founded colony
Motto	Noun	a short saying that expresses a rule to live by
Philanthropic	Adjective	showing kindness, charitable concern, and generosity toward other people
Enterprise	Noun	a new, often risky, venture that involves confidence and initiative
Buffer	Noun	Protector against impact, somebody or something that reduces shock or impact or protects against other harm, usually by interception
Debtors	Noun	People who owe money
Founding	Verb	to establish and organize something for the future such as an institution, colony, or business
