<u>Word</u>	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Loyalist	Noun	American who supported the British during the American Revolution
Backcountry	Noun	Rural area outside the city. Largely unpopulated area far away from city life
Royal Banner	Noun	a long piece of cloth, with the symbol of the British Empire
Patriot	Noun	In this case a supporter of the American Revolution. Also, a proud supporter or defender of his or her country and its way of life.
Militiamen	Noun	Members who serve in a civilian army (militia)
Morale	Noun	the general level of confidence or optimism felt by a person or group of people, especially as it affects discipline and motivation
Recruitment	Verb	to enlist somebody in a military force, or take part in enlisting people for a military force
