Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Re-founded	Verb	Founded again. Set up an institution or organization for the second time.
Faculty	Noun	the entire teaching staff of a university, college, or school, including any administrators holding academic rank
Memorial	Noun	something that is intended to remind people of somebody who has died or an event in which people died, e.g. a statue, speech, or ceremony
Founder	Noun	Somebody who founds something
Gothic Revival	Adjective	Architectural style that used medieval designs and elements
Remains	Noun	A dead person's body
Innovations	Noun	A new idea or way of doing something
Time Capsule	Noun	A container of items that represent past and present human history buried and saved for future generations to find and learn from.
