Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Courageously	Adverb	The quality of being brave, the ability to face danger, difficulty, or pain without being overcome by fear or being deflected from the task.
Sharecroppers	Noun	A farmer who farms on land they do not own and pay their rent with a share of the value of the crop
Ugliness	Adjective	having the potential to result in violence or hostility
Brutality	Noun	Cruel, harsh, or ruthless behavior
Racism	Noun	Prejudice against people who belong to other races
Freedom Rider	Noun	a civil rights activist who, during the early 1960s, joined one of the interracial groups riding buses through parts of the southern United States to protest against racial segregation
Segregation	Noun	the practice of keeping ethnic, racial, religious, or gender groups separate, especially by enforcing the use of separate schools, transportation, housing, and other facilities, and usually discriminating against a minority group
Interstate	Adjective	Connecting two or more states
Terminals	Noun	Station at the end of a transportation route
