Word	Part of Speech	Definition
Reluctantly	Adverb	Without enthusiasm
Secession	Noun	the withdrawal from the Union of 11 Southern States in 1860-1861 that led to the formation of the Confederacy and the beginning of the Civil War
Confederate	Noun	A supporter or soldier of the Confederate States of America during the Civil War
Provisional	Adjective	temporary
Moderate	Adjective	Middle-of –the road. Not 100% devoted to one side of an argument or viewpoint
Confirmed	Adjective	Makes something official and for-sure
Nationalist	Noun	Proud loyalty and devotion to a nation OR excessive devotion to nation
Draft	Noun	a system in which people are ordered to join the armed services in time of war
Alienated	Adjective	Cut-off, isolated
Outspokenly	Adjective	Telling how you feel without holding back or making it softer
Misgivings	Noun	A feeling of doubt especially when taking a course of action
Inauguration	Noun	the formal act of placing somebody in an official position, especially the President of the United States, or a ceremony held for this purpose
