Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Compromise	Noun	a settlement of a dispute in which two or more sides agree to accept less than they originally wanted
Accommodation	Noun	Adjustment and flexibility
Critic	Noun	Somebody finding fault in something
Advocating	Verb	To support and speak out in favor of something or someone
Activism	Noun	Taking action to achieve a social or political goal
Injustice	Noun	Unfair treatment
Lynching	Verb	To take somebody believed to have committed a crime and put him or her to death immediately and without trial, usually by hanging
Profoundly	Adjective	Very deep, strong, intense
