<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Dubbed	Verb	Give somebody a weekend
Deacon	Noun	Someone who assists a minister in a protestant church, or an ordained person ranking below a priest in the Catholic, Orthodox, and Episcopal traditions
Showmanship	Noun	somebody, especially a man, who is naturally talented in dramatic presentation or entertainment
Tempered	Verb	to make something less harsh or unacceptable, especially by adding something to it
Demeanor	Noun	somebody's behavior, manner, or appearance, especially as it reflects on character
Religious	Noun	a set of strongly-held beliefs, values, and attitudes that somebody lives by
Convictions	Noun	a belief or opinion that is held firmly
Mourners	Noun	A mourning person. A person who is showing sadness because somebody has died.
Tribute	Noun	something said or given to show gratitude, praise, or admiration
