| <u>Word</u> | <u>Part of Speech</u> | <u>Definition</u> |
|------------------|-----------------------|--|
| Producer | Noun | an organizer and administrator of the making of a movie, broadcast, or recording, or the staging of a play |
| Bombed | Verb | Doesn't do well. Doesn't earn much money |
| Mammoth | Adjective | Huge, large, difficult |
| Conducted | Verb | To do or run something |
| Screen Tests | Noun | an audition for a movie role in which an actor is filmed, or the film made of the audition |
| Partial Interest | Noun | A part of the profits from something. Usually a certain percentage |
| Chaos | Noun | Disorder, state of confusion |
| Screenplay | Noun | Film script |
| Nominated | Verb | to suggest somebody for a position or for an honor or award |
