Controversial	Adjective	Casing argument, disapproval or public debate
Opted	Verb	To choose something or choose to do something
Administration	Noun	Management of business
Appointed	Verb	To select or designate to fill an office or a position
Commission	Noun	a group of people authorized to carry out a duty
Dispute	Verb	to question or doubt the truth or validity of something
Bitter	Adjective	Resentful
Oppose	Verb	to be in competition, conflict, or battle with another person, team, or fighting force
Prohibition	Noun	in the United States, the period between 1919 and 1933 during which the manufacture, sale, and transportation of alcoholic beverages was forbidden by the 18th Amendment
Automobile Registration	Noun	a certificate showing that a motor vehicle has been properly registered with a state's department of motor vehicles
Anti-Semitism	Noun	policies, views, or actions that harm or discriminate against Jews
Lynched	Verb	to seize somebody believed to have committed a crime and put him or her to death immediately and without trial, usually by hanging
