<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Suffered	Verb	to experience or undergo something unpleasant or undesirable
Casualty Rate	Noun	The number of armed forces members killed or injured in combat divided by the total number of armed forces members
Strategic	Adjective	done with the intention of destroying an enemy's military capability
Targets	Noun	an area, surface, object, or person aimed at
Occupied	Verb	to invade and take control of a country, area, or building
Fortress	Noun	a fortified place with a long-term military presence, often including a town
Liberators	Noun	A person or group who frees or releases a person, group, population, or country from political or military control
Fighter Escorts	Noun	a World War II concept for a <i>fighter</i> aircraft designed to <i>take</i> bombers to and from their targets. They were designed to protect the bombers from enemy fire
Air Campaign	Noun	Military battle done in the air. Usually done as a support to ground activity
Allied	Noun	countries that opposed the Axis powers during the Second World War (1939–1945).consisted of France, Poland, the United Kingdom, the British Commonwealth nations, Australia, New Zealand, Canada and Union of South Africa
