Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Duel	Noun	a prearranged combat, especially in former times, between two people armed with lethal weapons, usually to settle a disagreement over a matter of honor
Highland Scots	Noun	Scottish immigrants from the highlands region of Scotland. They had a reputation for being good soldiers
Settlement	Noun	a place that has recently been populated with permanent residents
Prosperous	Adjective	Wealthy, financially successful
Provincial Congress	Noun	Legislative groups created during the American Revolutionary period to govern colonies
Continental Battalion	Noun	a military unit from the 13 colonies that later became the United States.
Ambitions	Noun	a strong feeling of wanting to be successful in life and achieve great things
Prominent	Adjective	Well-known
Theater	Noun	A geographic place where military operations take place during a conflict. For example in WWII there were European and Pacific theaters.
Siege	Noun	a military or police operation in which troops or the police surround a place and cut off all outside access to force surrender
