Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Legislature	Noun	An group of elected people with the power to make, change, and repeal laws
Floor Leaders	Noun	leaders of their political parties in each of the houses of the legislature.
Speaker of the House	Noun	the presiding officer of a legislative body such as the U.S. House of Representatives or the British House of Commons
Post	Noun	a position of employment
Throwback	Noun	Going back to an older way of doing things
Hardball	Noun	tough or ruthless behavior, especially in politics or business
Nod	Verb	Move head in agreement
Tide	Noun	the ebb or flow of water
