Profile	Noun	a short biographical account of somebody
Courage	Noun	Quality of being brave
Inner Workings	Noun	The manner of functioning or operating
Legislative	Adjective	relating to or being a part of the legislature or law making
Triumphs	Noun	Outstanding success
Initiatives	Noun	a plan or strategy designed to deal with a particular problem
Criticism	Noun	a spoken or written opinion or judgment of what is wrong or bad about somebody or something. Disapproval
Confederate Battle Emblem	Noun	The pattern found on the former battle flag of the Confederate states of America
Reconstruction	Noun	the period of U.S. history from 1865 through 1877, during which the states that had seceded during the Civil War were reorganized under federal control and later restored to the Union
