<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Roost	Noun	Place where birds sleep
Native	Adjective	Born or coming from a place
Poultry	Noun	domestic birds in general, e.g. chickens, turkeys, ducks, or geese, raised for meat or eggs
Civil Engineering	Noun	<i>Civil engineers</i> design things. These might be roads, buildings, airports, tunnels, dams, bridges, or water supply and sewage systems. They must consider many factors in their designs, from the costs to making sure the structure will stay intact during bad weather.
Depression	Noun	a period in which an economy is greatly affected by unemployment, low output, and poverty
Vertical Integration	Noun	Form of business organization in which all stages of production of a good, from the gathering of raw materials to the selling of the final product, are controlled by one company.
Raw Materials	Noun	a natural unprocessed material that is used in a manufacturing process
Processing	Verb	To prepare something using a series of steps or actions
Distribution	Verb	the handing out or delivery of things to a number of people
Innovative	Adjective	new and creative, especially in the way that something is done
Parkway	Noun	a wide stretch of public highway with grassy areas on both sides, often divided by a grassy median
