<u>Word</u>	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Corporation	Noun	a company recognized by law as a single body with its own powers and liabilities, separate from those of the individual members. Corporations perform many of the functions of private business, governments, educational bodies, and the professions.
Great Depression	Noun	The <i>Great Depression</i> was a severe worldwide <i>economic depression</i> in the decade preceding World War II.
Spirituality	Noun	Being concerned with things related to the soul and religion
Determined	Adjective	Having a set purpose and sticking to your goals
Work Ethic	Noun	a dedication to work, or belief in the moral value of hard work
Morsel	Noun	A small piece of food, usually that people find delicious
Pressure Cooked	Adjective	<i>Pressure cooking</i> is a method of cooking in a sealed vessel that does not permit air or liquids to escape below a preset pressure
Freestanding	Adjective	Independent, not attached to another building or location
Emphasizes	Verb	To stress something, to give importance to something
Philanthropic	Adjective	Charitable and generous







Foster	Verb	giving or receiving a home and parental care and
		upbringing, usually on a short-term basis,
		although unrelated by blood or adoption. Foster
		care is provided for children whose natural
		parents are dead, absent, or unfit or unable to
		look after them.
