<u>Word</u>	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Testify	Verb	to declare something that can be taken as evidence under oath in a court of law
Civic	Adjective	Connected with the duties and responsibilities of being a member of a community
Chamber of commerce	Noun	an organization of local businesspeople who work together to promote and protect common interests in trade
Moderate	Adjective	Middle-of-the road, not extreme or radical, seeing both sides of a situation
Integration	Noun	the process of opening a group, community, place, or organization to all, regardless of race, ethnicity, religion, gender, or social class
Embroiled	Verb	Involved in conflict, disagreement, or trouble
Unrest	Noun	Social or political discontent or protests, a senst of anxiousness in the community
Reinforced	Verb	To strengthen something, to give something support
Motto	Noun	Rule to live by
Progressive	Adjective	advocating social, economic, or political reform
Franchises	Noun	a professional sports team that is a member of an organized league
