Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Legislative	Adjective	involved in the writing and passing of laws
Attorney-General	Noun	a country's chief legal officer, and its government's chief legal adviser
Meddling	Noun	interference in somebody's personal life or concerns
Accreditation	Verb	to officially recognize a person or organization as having met a standard or criterion
Progressive	Adjective	belonging to a political party that calls itself progressive and pushes social reform
Reforms	Verb	to change and improve something
Abolished	Verb	to put an end to something such as a law
Poll Tax	Noun	a flat-rate tax on all members of a population, often to be able to vote
Legacy	Noun	something that is handed down or remains from a previous generation or time
