| Word | Part of Speech | <u>Definition</u> |
|------------------|----------------|--|
| Locomotive | Noun | a railway vehicle that provides the motive power for a train either through steam or some other type of engine |
| Joint Resolution | Noun | a resolution passed by both Houses of Congress or both houses of any bicameral legislative body, |
| Enduring | Adjective | Persistent or surviving in the face of difficulties |
| Fascination | Noun | Complete interest and attention in something interesting |
| Raiding Party | Noun | A group of people who plan and carry out a sudden attack to try and take or destroy something |
| Dashed | Verb | a quick purposeful movement by a person or a group of people in a particular direction |
| Execution | Noun | the killing of somebody as part of a legal or extralegal process |
| Federal Lawsuit | Noun | A case in federal court between two groups |
