Literary	Adjective	relating to literature, writing, or the study of literature
Writers Workshop	Noun	The Iowa <i>Writers' Workshop</i> is a two-year residency program which culminates in the submission of a creative thesis
Rubbed Elbows	Verb	to associate with someone; to work closely with someone.
Diagnosed	Verb	to identify an illness or disorder in a patient through an interview, physical examination, and medical tests and other procedures
Lupus	Noun	a long-term autoimmune disorder that may affect the skin, joints, kidneys, brain, and other organs.
