 Vocabulary

<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Independence	Noun	freedom from dependence on or control by another person, organization, or state
Commissioned	Noun	Given a job or task to complete
Battalion	Noun	Military unit with a headquarter and three or more companies, batteries, or other smaller groups of soldiers
Surrendered	Verb	To officially say that the other side has won so that the fighting will end
Paroled	Noun	a promise, given by a prisoner of war as a condition of release, either not to escape or not to take up arms again
Fate	Noun	The force or principle people believe predetermines events
Massacre	Noun	The killing of a large number of people
Outraged	Verb	To make somebody feel intense anger
Decade	Noun	Period of 10 years
