<u>Word</u>	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Portrayed	Verb	To represent somebody in words or visually
Corrupt	Adjective	Immoral, dishonest, using your power for personal gain
Carpetbagger	Noun	a Northerner who moved to the southern United States after the Civil War, especially one seeking political or commercial advantage
Equality	Noun	rights, treatment, quantity, or value equal to all others in a specific group
Confederates	Noun	Supporter or soldier of the Confederate States of America during the Civil War
Secession	Noun	Withdrawal of the Southern States from the Union
Republican	Noun	Belonging to or supporting he Republican party in the United States – During the Civil War and Reconstruction period this party supported ending slavery and giving rights to Black citizens
Investment	Noun	Use of money to help a business or industry start in order to get future profits
Industry	Noun	organized economic activity connected with the production, manufacture, or construction of a particular product or range of products
Acquitted	Verb	to declare officially that somebody is not guilty of a charge
Prominent	Adjective	Well-known, distinguished, important
Predecessor	Noun	Somebody who held a position or job before somebody else
