<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Transformed	Verb	To change somebody or something completely and dramatically
Allies	Noun	The <i>Allies of World War II</i> were the countries that opposed the Axis powers during the Second World War (1939–1945). Included the United States, France, Great Britain and other smaller countries. The Soviet Union joined the allies in 1941.
Corporation	Noun	a company recognized by law as a single body with its own powers and liabilities, separate from those of the individual members. Corporations perform many of the functions of private business, governments, educational bodies, and the professions.
Prime	Adjective	Best, or the highest quality
Boosters	Noun	an enthusiastic promoter or supporter of something or somebody, e.g. of a team
Lobbied	Verb	to attempt to persuade a political representative or influential person to support or oppose a particular cause
Symbolized	Verb	to represent something by means of a symbol
Industrial	Adjective	relating to, used in, or created by industry
Modern	Adjective	Belonging to the present period of history, especially used to describe someone or something that has ideas and activities considered new, advanced and maybe non-traditional
