<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Color-Blind	Adjective	not discriminating between people on the grounds of their ethnic group or the color of their skin
Abolitionist	Noun	an antislavery campaigner in the 18th and 19th centuries
Resettling	Verb	to provide a group or population with a new place to live and transfer it there
Association	Group	a group of people or organizations joined together for a purpose
Unprecedented	Adjective	Lacking an earlier example, having no earlier equal
Freedmen	Noun	African Americans set free from slavery
Reconstruction	Noun	the period of U.S. history from 1865 through 1877, during which the states that had seceded during the Civil War were reorganized under federal control and later restored to the Union
